



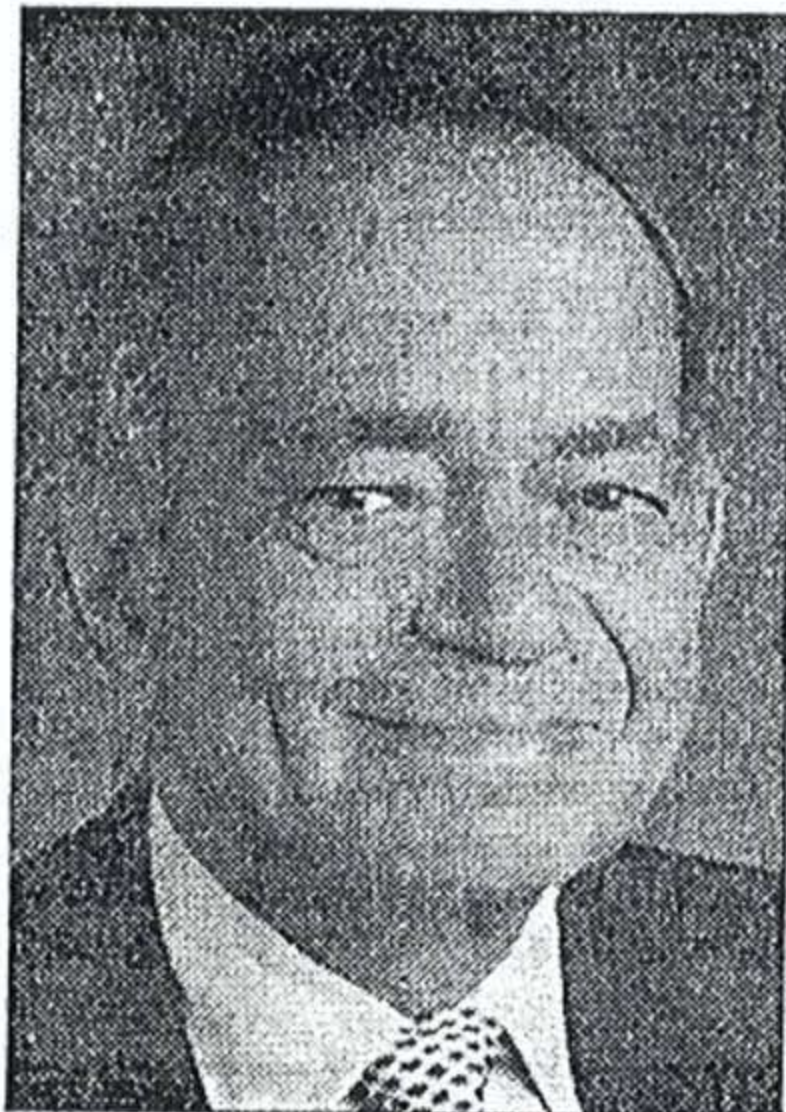
# KUP'S COLUMN
